# **AGENDA ITEMS**

- 1) Call Meeting to Order / Introduce Committee Members
- 2) Update on dress code decision-*Dress code will remain the same as in previous years.*Boarman feels confident that if students are not able to purchase shirts that we have systems in place to assist families with the financial burden of getting appropriate uniform shirts.
- 3) Advisory Discussion Items
  - Valentine's Day
    - i. How to improve communication?
      - 1. Include visuals showing Yes/No
      - 2. Share procedures on announcements so students are well informed.
      - 3. Start sharing message about one month before Valentine's Day.
      - 4. Do not have teachers send a list. Ask parents to have students simply write who the Valentine is from.
      - 5. Allow one individually wrapped treat with a Valentine
      - 6. Send printed directions home in Tuesday folder.
      - 7. Be clear with direct verbiage of "Do not" instead of "avoid" because that seemed more like a suggestion.
      - 8. Include that treat bags will be sent home and student will not be able to share them.
      - 9. Include students may not deliver Valentines to friends in other classes. They may only share with their homeroom classmates.

- 10. Add to Bulldog Basics that no treat bags are allowed for any parties.
- 11. Move the information about treats to the top of the list.
- ii. Should it be one of the two designated party days?
  - 1. Vote was No. Keep our two designated party days as Winter and EOY parties.

#### Awards Day
